ST IGNATIUS LOYOLA, founder of the Society of Jesus. His feast day is 31st July, the date he died on in 1556. A Basque courtier and soldier, Inigo de Loyola was gravely wounded during the battle of Pamplona in 1521. During his convalescence, he experienced a profound spiritual conversion that began his lifelong commitment to God and service. From his personal experience and prayer, he articulated a guide for finding God, to "find God in all things." and self called the Spiritual Exercises that
