To mark the centenary of the birth of Blessed Oscar Romaro, there will be Evensong: National Ecumenical Celebration on Saturday 23rd Sept at 3pm. Westminster Abbey. As Archbishop in El Salvador in the 1970s, Oscar Romero became increasingly outspoken about human rights violations, which ultimately led to his assassination in 1980 when he was shot whilst celebrating Mass. He was beatified by Pope Francis on May 23rd 2015.
