ADOREMUS CENTRE "In appointing Fr. John Lavers as parish priest of St. Anne and St. Mary Magdalen, Alderney, I am also pleased to announce that from the autumn, a community of Marian Franciscan nuns will move into the convent next to the Alderney church. Together with the parishioners, I have asked them to establish what will be called the "**Adoremus Centre.**" The Centre will be a house of perpetual prayer to support the mission and new evangelisation work of our Diocese, to support especially our clergy, and to pray for vocations. It will also be a centre of pastoral care, charity and outreach not only to the Catholics of the island but also to anyone in need. In time, the Adoremus Centre will seek to establish a guest-house that can receive retreatants. I hope too it will live-stream over the internet the Mass and other liturgies so that people from across the Diocese can email prayer-requests and join in its spiritual life. I am sure you too will rejoice with me at this project, which I have long wanted to establish. Please pray for God's blessing on it and its success." **Bishop Philip**

THE FEASTS OF THE EPIPHANY AND THE ASCENSION 2018 The Vatican has approved a decision from the Catholic bishops in England and Wales to move two Holy Days of Obligation back to their original dates. Effective starting on December 3rd. The first Sunday of Advent of this year, the Catholic dioceses in England and Wales will celebrate the **Epiphany of the Lord on January 6**, and the **Ascension of the Lord on the Thursday after the 6th Sunday of Easter.**
