### Society of Jesus JUBILARIANS

**Four Jesuits with strong links to Corpus Christi parish and Jesuit community (CCJC) celebrate anniversaries of entering the Society this week:**

**75 YEARS:** Fr Michael Flannery, teacher in Liverpool and London, university chaplain in Manchester, parish ministry in Worcester and Boscombe, community superior at Mount St Mary's and Stonyhurst.

**70 YEARS:** Frs Leo Arnold and Paul Hackett (brother of Peter & Mark): were parishioners of Corpus Christi and joined the Society of Jesus together in 1946. For Leo priestly ministry has been in Lebanon & Rome, where he has lived (& taught Arabic) for the past thirty-five years. Paul has been always in Britain, with the diversity of parishes in inner-city Manchester, the Scottish Highlands and Islands, and here in Boscombe itself (1977-1980).

**50 YEARS:** Our Parish Priest joined the Society in 1966. Before coming Boscombe earlier this year, Fr Adrian Howell has served the parishioners in Loughton (Essex), Brixton in south London, Hurst Green and Stonyhurst in Lancashire, and St Francis Xavier's in Liverpool.

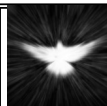

**SCHOOL ADMISSIONS Completion of 'CONFIRMATION OF RELIGIOUS PRACTICE' or SIF Forms**

**OUR procedure for members of Corpus Christi Parish:** To have a Religious Practice form signed by a priest, please put the **completed form** (**Please tick the appropriate attendance box and contact details but do not fill in the comments box or sign the form**) into an envelope with a **SEPARATE COVERING LETTER** that must include your contact details (**inc tel number**) and your regularity to Mass, how long you have worshipped at Corpus Christi, First Holy Communion date & other involvement in the church. **Please be as honest and open as possible.** Then drop it through the door of the Parish Office, No:18 St James Square.

**Out of courtesy, please do not ask any Priest directly to sign a form.**

**All St Peter's School Forms** - the signed form will be **GIVEN DIRECTLY** to St Peter's, **not returned to parents.**

**Corpus Christi & Primary School Forms** (except St Peter's) - parents need to pick up from the Parish Office.

**STANDING ORDERS** (Can be Gift Aided) **Setting up a standing order.** You will need the parish bank details, which are: **Sort code 30-93-04. Parish Account number: 01786041.** ("It's so easy to do!!")
