THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD Year C 10th January 2016.

WARM AND HEARTFELT THANKS to all who helped in any way over Christmastide and Epiphany to prepare the church so beautifully, to all who read, served, did quiet sacristy work, put out more than 100 extra chairs, cleaned, put up the lovely crib, and so much else: they know who they are, and all of us in the parish owe them our deepfelt thanks.

LIKEWISE, all our Jesuit Community here wish to thank you for such thoughtfulness and generosity with all the cards, prayers and gifts you showered upon us, not least on Fr David, Fr Peter, Fr Kevin, Fr Tony and myself.

TODAY SPUC are holding their annual White Flower Appeal. There'll be a voluntary retiring collection for them at the end of all masses. Warm thanks on their behalf.

Today's Feast of the Baptism of Jesus links in very well with the Year of Mercy theme. Mercy, loving-kindness, consolation, compassion, are all words which occur in today's Readings. The Second Reading is the same as the middle reading at the dawn mass on Christmas Day, and is worth quoting in full. "When the kindness and love of God our saviour for mankind were revealed, it was not because he was concerned with any righteous actions we might have done ourselves; it was for no reason except his own compassion that he saved us, by means of the cleansing water of rebirth and by renewing us with the Holy Spirit which he has so generously poured over us through Jesus Christ our Saviour. He did this that we should be justified by his grace, to become heirs looking forward to inheriting eternal life."

The First Reading today begins with: "Console my people, console them...speak to the heart". The Gospel echoes this "speaking to the heart". As Jesus was at prayer after his own baptism "heaven opened and the Holy Spirit descended on him in bodily shape, like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, 'You are my Son, the Beloved; my favour rest on you.'" I am more and more convinced that individuals who are graced with adult baptism have that same special privilege that Jesus had, for they know their belovedness through the conviction that our Loving Lord has graced them with this wondrous free gift of baptism, being plunged into the dying and rising of Jesus.

What matters for you and me, though, at whatever age and stage we were baptized, is that we grow in our living sense of our belovedness and favour with our Loving Lord. And in this Jubilee Year of Mercy especially let's pray for one another regularly that each of may grow into that living awareness that we're on the receiving end of God's mercy, loving-kindness, consolation and compassion, and hand on those gifts to those whose lives we touch each day. That way our baptism comes ever more alive!
