**JESUIT PASTORAL CONFERENCE 2017** The delegates from Corpus Christi joined 11 other Jesuit Parishes and Pastoral Centres in Swanwick, Derbyshire from 8-10 June. The Conference considered three important documents and messages of joy from Pope Francis, firstly The Joy of the Gospel (Evangelii Gaudium), reflects on how we live in relation to each other, living alongside each other with kindness, generosity and compassion. Secondly, The Joy of Love (Laetitia Amoris) raises awareness of the holiness of the home whatever our individual circumstances, and the importance of non judgemental love, both in our own family life and within the Parish family. Finally, in Care of our Common Home or 'Joy of Creation' (Laudato Si) Pope Francis considers the importance of the earth as our common home which God made for us all and how our actions affect our environment and each other. The delegates considered how these important messages could be highlighted throughout the Parish, through small, practical steps for the benefit of our whole community.
