ADOREMUS "I am the bread of life" John 6 **EUCCHARISTIC PILGRIMAGE & CONGRESS Liverpool 7th - 9th September 2018** "Adoremus will be a unique opportunity for the Church to gather and reflect on the centrality of the Eucharist and particularly to explore the place of Eucharistic Adoration. Over three days from 7 - 9 September 2018, we will hold a Eucharistic Congress to celebrate the place of the Eucharist in our lives.." **Cardinal Vincent N.**

Adoration of the Eucharist, as a living and personal encounter with Christ, is an essential & primary form of evangelisation that reawakens in us the impulse for God instilled when God created us. Adoration deepens our relationship with Jesus. He enables us to be more effective disciples who will be better able to lead others to the life of the Church that has the Eucharist at its heart. Out of that innermost desire, we are drawn to be missionary disciples and know His gift of peace. The last Eucharistic Congress was in 1908!
