**THE MEDAILLE TRUST** Day of Prayer - 8th February has been designated by the Pontifical Council for Justice and Peace and the International Union of Superiors General an annual day of prayer and awareness against human trafficking. It is the feast day of St. Josephine Bakhita, who was kidnapped as a child and sold into slavery in Sudan and Italy. She learned from the Canossian nuns that she was created in the image of God and possessed human dignity. Once she asserted herself and refused to be enslaved, Josephine became a Canossian sister and dedicated her life to sharing her testament of deliverance from slavery and comforting the poor and suffering. She was declared a Saint in 2000. The Medaille Trust is a Catholic charity who supports the victims of slavery and human trafficking in the UK. They have 9 Safe Houses across the country. As well as providing victims with a safe roof over their heads, the Trust offers them physical and psychological help.
