SIXTH SUNDAY of EASTER Year B 6th May 2018



One of the implications of the Easter season is that that God has made possible for us a whole series of new relationships, with God, with Jesus, and with each other, regardless of race or culture. The first reading presents this issue in a very challenging way. Peter, and one or two others in that early Church, have to be taught that the good news about Jesus is not reserved exclusively to Jews. For he has been summoned to the house of a professional Roman soldier, Cornelius, a prayerful centurion. Cornelius himself has a lesson or two to learn; when Peter arrives, he tries to kneel down and worship him, and has to be told "up you get - I am also a human being". Then Peter proclaims the discovery that he in his turn has made: "God is not a

snob - someone of any nationality [even a Gentile]] who fears God, and does what is justice, is acceptable to God". Then something quite remarkable happens: "while Peter was still speaking, the Holy Spirit fell on all those who heard the word". Now the Holy Spirit was for those earliest Christians a powerful experience; if you had it, you could not remain in any doubt about it. So Peter's Jewish companions now see for themselves that the Spirit is not reserved just for Jews, for here you have non-Jews "speaking in tongues and magnifying God". And so Peter is encouraged even to offer baptism to these Gentiles. It may seem obvious to us today; but in that first century of the Church's existence, it represented a huge leap of faith

The second reading, as it has been throughout the Easter season, is from the first "letter" of John. It too expresses the new relationship that Easter has brought about. Here, though, the relationship is within the little group of Christians. And the name of this relationship is "love": "Beloved, let us love each other, because love is from God, and everyone who loves is born of God". God's love is then given tangible form, for us to imitate: "God sent his only Son into the world, that we might live through him". And the love is God's initiative: "not that we have loved God, but that God loved us, and sent his Son". www.catholic-chaplaincy.org.uk/
