WEEKDAY HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION From now on only the 2 masses on the actual day of the Holy Obligation days that fall in during the week, will be celebrated. Masses will remain at 10.00am and 7.00pm but there will be NO 7.00pm EVENING VIGIL (said the day before).

This change takes place immediately, so will be in place for the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Wednesday 15th August and for All Saints on Thursday 1st November and from then on.
