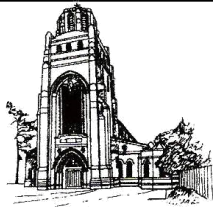

MESSAGE FROM BISHOP PHILIP in light of the Report from the Pennsylvania Grand Jury.

"I am sure that, like me, you were horrified, ashamed and angry when you read the report from the Pennsylvania Grand Jury about the sexual abuse of children by members of the clergy there these last 70 years. It is, in the words of Cardinal DiNardo, a 'moral catastrophe.' So many clergy seem to have been involved, so many victims. Whilst these are historic allegations and today's situation is different, even so this scandal soils the entire Church. It tests our faith. It can make us distrust the Church, especially its bishops and priests. We know as human beings we are all sinners and that the Church, which is the Body of Christ and the Temple of the Holy Spirit, is made up of sinful people like you and me. Yet we ask: How could this have happened? How could this have been allowed to happen? More, what should we do? What can we do? The first thing we need to do, every Catholic, is to pray for the victims. We need to offer the Rosary for the healing of the victims and their memories. We need to pray too for the forgiveness of those who harmed them and for the Church leaders who mishandled cases or sought to cover up. Full of sorrow, we need to make reparation for all the damage done. Constructively, we also need to pray for vocations to all states of life and ministry in the Church today, but especially for good priests, for inspiring priests who will be happy, healthy and holy, who will witness to the Divine nature of their calling & create an environment that is safe and wholesome, a welcoming Church for all." *A few copies of full letter at back of church*

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS Completion of 'CONFIRMATION OF RELIGIOUS PRACTICE' or SIF Forms

OUR PROCEDURE for members of CORPUS CHRISTI PARISH: To have a Religious Practice form signed by a priest:

1. **Complete the SIF form (Please tick the appropriate attendance box and contact details)**
2. Write a **SEPARATE COVERING LETTER** (include your telephone number) stating your regularity to **WEEKEND Mass**, how long you have worshipped at Corpus Christi, & any other involvement in the church. **Please be as honest and open as possible.**
3. Put both the form & covering letter in an envelope & post through the door of Parish Office, No:18 St James Square.


OUT OF COURTESY, PLEASE DO NOT ASK ANY PRIEST DIRECTLY TO SIGN A FORM.

RETURN OF ALL FORMS: If the form is correct and has a covering letter it will be offered to the Parish Priest for signing. Once validated and stamped, parents will be contacted to come and pick it up from the Parish Office to take to the school.

PLEASE NOTE: The Parish Office will be closed from 11th to 23rd September. All forms submitted will be dealt with when the Office reopens on the 24th September. *This still gives ample time for forms to be submitted to the schools before the application deadline.*
