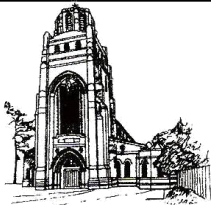

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS Completion of 'CONFIRMATION OF RELIGIOUS PRACTICE' or SIF Forms

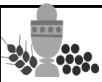
OUR PROCEDURE for members of CORPUS CHRISTI PARISH: To have a Religious Practice form signed by a priest:

1. **Complete the SIF form (Please tick the appropriate attendance box and contact details)**
2. Write a **SEPARATE COVERING LETTER** (include your telephone number) stating your regularity to **WEEKEND Mass**, how long you have worshipped at Corpus Christi, & any other involvement in the church. **Please be as honest and open as possible.**
3. Put both the form & covering letter in an envelope & post through the door of Parish Office, No:18 St James Square.

OUT OF COURTESY, PLEASE DO NOT ASK ANY PRIEST DIRECTLY TO SIGN A FORM.

RETURN OF ALL FORMS: If the form is correct and has a covering letter it will be offered to the Parish Priest for signing. Once validated and stamped, parents will be contacted to come and pick it up from the Parish Office to take to the school.

PLEASE NOTE: The Parish Office will be closed from 11th to 23rd September. All forms submitted will be dealt with when the Office reopens on the 24th September. *This still gives ample time for forms to be submitted to the schools before the application deadline, which is 31st October 2018.*



FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME We have had many enquiries already about First Holy Communion. Just to clarify that this is a **PARISH based Programme**, not related to any school. If you live in the Parish boundaries and/or worship here regularly at the weekend (ie: not Wednesday school Mass) then your child will be considered. **Please make sure you apply to your local parish church, who may have an earlier closing date than us.**
