<u>ARCHANGELS MICHAEL</u>, <u>GABRIEL AND RAPHAEL</u> Feast day 29th September. They are the only angels named in Sacred Scripture and all three have important roles in the history of salvation.

Saint Michael is the "Prince of the Heavenly Host," the leader of all the angels. His name is Hebrew for "Who is like God?" and was the battle cry of the good angels against Lucifer and his followers when they rebelled against God. Christian tradition recognizes four offices of Saint Michael: (i) to fight against Satan (ii) to rescue the souls of the faithful from the power of the enemy, especially at the hour of death. (iii) to be the champion of God's people, (iv) to call away from earth and bring men's souls to judgment.

"I am Gabriel, who stand before God." (Luke 1, 19) Saint Gabriel, whose name means "God's strength," is mentioned four times in the Bible. Most significant are Gabriel's two mentions in the New Testament: to announce the birth of John the Baptist to his father Zacharias, and the at Incarnation of the Word in the womb of Mary. Christian tradition suggests that it is he who appeared to St. Joseph and to the shepherds, and also that it was he who "strengthened" Jesus during his agony in the garden of Gethsemane.

"I am the angel Raphael, one of the seven, who stand before the Lord" (Tob 12:15) Saint Raphael, whose name means "God has healed" because of his healing of Tobias' blindness in the Book of Tobit. Tobit is the only book in which he is mentioned. His office is generally accepted by tradition to be that of healing and acts of mercy. Raphael is also identified with the angel in John 5:1-4 who descended upon the pond and bestowed healing powers upon it so that the first to enter it after it moved would be healed of whatever infirmity he was suffering. <a href="https://www.catholicnewsagency.com/">www.catholicnewsagency.com/</a>

OUR PROCEDURE for members of CORPUS CHRISTI PARISH: To have a Religious Practice form signed by a priest:

- 1. Complete the SIF form (Please tick the appropriate attendance box and contact details)
- Write a <u>SEPARATE COVERING LETTER</u> (include your telephone number) stating your regularity to **WEEKEND**Mass, how long you have worshipped at Corpus Christi, & any other involvement in the church.

  Please be as honest and open as possible.
- I 3. Put both the form & covering letter in an envelope & post through the door of Parish Office, No:18 St James Square.

## OUT OF COURTESY, PLEASE DO NOT ASK ANY PRIEST DIRECTLY TO SIGN A FORM.

**RETURN OF ALL FORMS:** If the form is correct and has a covering letter it will be offered to the Parish Priest for signing. Once validated and stamped, parents will be contacted to come and pick it up from the Parish Office to take to the school.

PLEASE NOTE: The Parish Office will be closed from 11th to 23rd September. All forms submitted will be dealt with when the Office reopens on the 24th September. Please do not panic. This still gives ample time for forms to be submitted to the schools before the application deadline.


Something else that makes us smile is to be more kind.
