PRISONERS' WEEK 14-20th October. Prisoners' Sunday today marks the first day of the ecumenical Prisons Week, a week of prayer to raise awareness of issues faced by those affected by the criminal justice system.

PACT is the Catholic charity that works with prisoners' families, prisoners and people with previous convictions often find themselves on the margins of society due to the social stigma associated with imprisonment. They are often forgotten or come lower down on the list of causes to 'hold a hand out to'. But the gospel reminds us of our duties towards them, 'I was naked and you clothed me, sick and you visited me, in prison and you came to see me; (Matthew 25:36). Pact's work embodies the Christian value of mercy and belief in the innate dignity of every human being. This year's theme 'We press on—Together, In Hope' recognises the vital role we all need to play in the coming together as a community, in compassion and without judgement, to offer hope and a fresh start to all those affected by imprisonment. We hope that you will join us in marking this day and thank you for your ongoing support. - Write a <u>SEPARATE COVERING LETTER (include your telephone number) stating your regularity to WEEKEND</u> Mass, how long you have worshipped at Corpus Christi, & any other involvement in the church. Please be as honest and open as possible.
- 3. Put both the form & covering letter in an envelope & post through the door of Parish Office, No:18 St James Square.

OUT OF COURTESY, PLEASE DO NOT ASK ANY PRIEST DIRECTLY TO SIGN A FORM.

RETURN OF ALL FORMS: If the form is correct and has a covering letter it will be offered to the Parish Priest for signing. Once validated and stamped, parents will be contacted to come and pick it up from the Parish Office to take to the school.
