**LOCAL EVENTS: Holocaust Memorial in Wimborne Minster, Saturday 26th January at 2pm.** John Fieldsend will tell how he and his brother came to the UK in the transports organised by Nicholas Winton. His parents and most of the rest of his family died in the various camps. Erica Prean will describe her childhood in Aachen before she and mother managed to get to England with only 1 suitcase and 10 marks. A short video clip will be shown of Felicia Carmelly telling how she and her mother were driven from their home in the Carpathian Mountains of Romania along with 150,000 Jewish men, women and children and 185,000 local Ukranian Jews were murdered. Students from the Queen Elizabeth School Wimborne will perform a piece written in the Vilna ghetto by the poet Shmerke Kaczerginski, with music composed by Yankel Krimski. The words will be sung in Yiddish.

**Holocaust Memorial Day in Poole, Sunday 27th January 2019, 2pm – 4.30pm at Lighthouse Poole**  
Holocaust survivor Joanna Millen (birth name Bela Rosenthal) Our main speaker is Holocaust survivor Joanna Millen (birth name Bela Rosenthal) who was orphaned at 18 months old when her mother contracted tuberculosis in Terezin concentration camp in 1944 leaving Bela alone in the world. Joanna will share with us the story of how she survived. We will also be remembering the 80th anniversary of the Kindertransport and the 25th anniversary of the Rwandan genocide.
