GOOD NEWS TO THE POOR The mission of Jesus is expressed with great force in today's Gospel. "To let the oppressed go free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour." Human nature has some in-built resistance to God, that results from original sin deep in our DNA. It's a refusal to listen, and an insistence on going our own way. Some basic rebelliousness and pride leads to the blindness and oppression named in today's gospel. This is not something that we can resolve without some help from outside. But Jesus has come to join us, to lead us, to save us, and this is the powerful Good News he announced in the Synagogue at Nazareth. "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor."
