FROM THE RECENT SAFEGUARDING SUMMIT IN ROME VATICAN ANNOUNCES CONCRETE COMMITMENTS & INITIATIVES TO PROTECT CHILDREN

Concrete Initiatives: Father Federico Lombardi SJ, as Moderator of the meeting, announced these initiatives:

1. The imminent publication of a Motu proprio by the Pope, providing rules and regulations to safeguard minors and vulnerable adults within Vatican City State.
2. The distribution of a 'vademeccum' (or rulebook) to Bishops around the world, explaining their juridical and pastoral duties and responsibilities with regard to protecting children.
3. The creation of an operative 'task force', comprising competent experts, to assist those Bishops' Conferences that may lack the necessary resources or expertise to confront the issue of safeguarding minors, and deal with abuse.

The Organising Committee will also be meeting with heads of Vatican Curia departments to discuss how best to follow-up the work of the meeting.

Last impressions: Jesuit priest Father Hans Zollner, a member of the Organising Committee and Head of the Centre for Child Protection at the Pontifical Gregorian University, spoke of a "qualitative and quantitative leap along a decade-long journey that will continue". Attitudes have changed, he said, and people have been transformed: they are determined to "go back home and do something about it". Right now, concluded Fr. Zollner, "we need to focus on what we have done here" at this meeting in the Vatican, and to tackle "the systemic roots of the problem". FROM DORSET POLICE Tenancy Deposit Scheme Alert Action Fraud have received several reports where fraudsters are claiming to be landlords of properties offered for rent online. Prior to a viewing the suspect requests that the individuals pay a deposit and sometimes a month's rent upfront, claiming that this money will be put into the Tenancy Deposit Scheme, and therefore protected under government legislation. After the individual pays the money, the suspect sends a bogus email purporting to be from the Tenancy Deposit Scheme confirming they have received their deposit. However, this is not the case as the money was sent directly to an account associated with the suspect and the victim is left out of pocket and without the home they had thought to be putting a deposit on. **What You Need To Do:** ♦Make sure you, or a reliable contact, has viewed the property with an agent or landlord before agreeing to rent a property. ♦Don't be rushed or pressured ♦Only transfer funds when you're satisfied it is a genuine property with valid contract ♦Only pay for goods or service by bank transfer if you know & trust the person. Payments via bank transfer offer no victim fraud protection. ♦Once you've paid your deposit, check it's protected on TDS website (www.tenancydepositscheme.com).
