NEWSLETTER 13th SUNDAY of Year B 27th June 2021

"In the Gospel reading today (Mark 5: 21-43) we read of Jesus' healing by touching. Jesus touched people in various ways; with his words; with his hands; with his love. The Eucharist brings us very close to Jesus. And we too need his healing touch in our lives.

In today's Gospel we have two more miracles. These miracles show that Jesus' saving power and love can overcome sickness and even death. I have been encouraged in my faith, in the challenging days, by the quiet faithful attendance of the those who are able to come to the Church daily to pray for God's healing touch in their lives, and in the lives of others. Our dedication "Corpus Christi" reminds us of the love Jesus wants to share with us.

First reading (Wisdom 1: 13-15, 2: 23-24) God did not make us for death but for life.

Second reading (2 Cor 8: 7,9, 13-15) St Paul is appealing to the Corinthians to help the poor and needy in the Church and Jerusalem.

Gospel (Mark 5: 21-43) The healing ministry of Jesus is illustrated.

This week we celebrate the **Feast of Ss Peter and Paul (Tuesday 29th) Mass times are 10am and 7.00pm.**

SOLEMNITY OF SAINTS PETER AND PAUL. "Normally, it is a holy day of obligation: please do try to get to Mass. "Peter, a poor fisherman, was called by Christ to lead and care for Christ's entire flock: "Feed my sheep!" (John 21: 7). It was Peter who received a vision confirming that the Good News was to be preached to those the Jews considered unclean, the pagan Gentiles (cf. Acts 10: 9-16). Paul, the former Pharisee, carried out this missionary mandate. In the course of his preaching, he was flogged, beaten, stoned, shipwrecked and attacked by brigands (cf. 2 Cor 11: 24-27). Both Peter and Paul ended their ministries in Rome, around the year 64. Tradition has it that Peter was crucified upside down and Paul was beheaded. What unites Peter and Paul is Jesus - his love for them and their love for him" (Magnificat). On this feastday, please pray for the whole catholic Church and all its clergy, religious and laity, for the unity of the Church and for its evangelising mission."
