18th SUNDAY of Year B 1st August 2021

"Last Sunday we heard how Jesus gave bread to the people in the wilderness. But when they come back the next day for more he said to them "Do not work for perishable food but for the food that endures to eternal life" We come to Mass at Corpus Christi because we know we need another kind of food and support that only Christ can give us.

Today's readings. First reading (Exodus 16: 2-4, 12-15) God feeds his people in the desert.

Second reading (Ephesians 4: 17. 20-24) St Paul urges the Ephesians (and us) to live lives that are in keeping with their baptismal calling.

Gospel (John 6: 24-35) Jesus declares himself as the true bread from Heaven, of which the manna provided by Moses was but a foreshadow.

The Son of Man did not come down from above merely to satisfy physical hunger. He came to give a heavenly bread that people will eat and never become hungry. He came to nourish us spiritually and sustain us for eternal life. The bread of truth given to us by Jesus "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life" Jesus feeds us in the Eucharist. He gives us the bread of truth that enables us to envisage the Kingdom. He give us life." God Bless. **Fr Adrian.**

CHANGES & LIFTING OF COVID RESTRICTIONS - we ask that people still behave with caution and common sense.

1. There will no longer be a need to book places for Sunday Masses but please **sign in or use the QR code** for Test and Trace purposes. Saturday 6pm and Sunday 9.30am Masses will still be livestreamed. The 5pm Sunday Mass will also be reinstated from September 2021.
2. The one way system will remain in force and please still maintain safe distancing.
3. Face masks to be worn according to your personal preference. Please be courteous to peoples' choice.
4. The Saturday 10am Mass will be reinstated - so daily Mass will be Monday to Saturday at 10am.
5. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will remain Mon - Fri, 10.30am - 11am (when the Church will be closed) and Wednesdays 7pm-8pm.
6. Sacrament of Reconciliation will be reinstated after Saturday 10am Mass and the church will then be closed until 5.45pm. Sacrament of Reconciliation will also be on Wednesdays 10.30 - 11am.
7. The Memorial Room and toilets will remain shut until September.

"In September, if conditions permit, we hope to open the Church for longer and welcome back Altar Servers. Thank you to all who have enabled the Church to be open by your generous volunteering, to greet people and clean the Church." **Fr Adrian**

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS Completion of

'CONFIRMATION OF RELIGIOUS PRACTICE' or 'SIF' Form

OUR PROCEDURE for members of CORPUS CHRISTI PARISH: To have a Religious Practice form signed by a priest:

1. **Complete the SIF form (Please tick the appropriate attendance box and contact details)**
2. Write a **SEPARATE COVERING LETTER** (include your telephone number) stating your regularity to **WEEKEND Mass**, how long you have worshipped at Corpus Christi, & any other involvement in the church. **Please be as honest and open as possible.**
3. Put both the form & covering letter in an envelope & post through the door of Parish Office, No:18 St James Square.

OUT OF COURTESY, PLEASE DO NOT ASK ANY PRIEST DIRECTLY TO SIGN A FORM.

RETURN OF ALL FORMS: If the form is correct and has a covering letter it will be offered to the Parish Priest for signing. Once processed, parents will be contacted to come and pick it up from the Parish Office to take directly to the school. (SECONDARY SCHOOL FORMS closing date is **29th October 2021** Please do not leave it to the last minute, as forms will
