"Life offers us a fundamental choice. If we choose to follow the words of Jesus, we are guaranteed a share in a unique, loving and utterly faithful relationship with God.

First reading (Joshua 24: 1-2, 15-18) Joshua confronts the people with a vital decision - to serve the one true God or to serve false gods.

Second reading (Ephesians 5: 21-32) St Paul used the image of a marriage relationship to express the bond that exists between Christ and the Church.

Gospel (John 6: 60-69) The disciples of Jesus are faced with a decision - to stay with Jesus or to leave him.

One of the greatest gifts God has given us is a freedom of choice. God's respect for our freedom is a sign of his great love for us. Possessive love tries to control the loved one. God does not control us. He has given us the freedom to choose between good and evil. If we choose wrongly God does not stop loving us. God wants to heal and forgive us. If we follow Jesus Christ we will always be free. We are free, not when we do whatever we please, but when we do what is right." **Fr Adrian.**

PRAYERS FOR PLYMOUTH The Right Reverend Mark O'Toole, Bishop of Plymouth, has issued a statement on the fatal shootings which took place in the Keyham area of Plymouth in which six people were killed on the evening of Thursday 12 August. "It is with a deep sense of shock and sadness that we heard of the terrible shootings in our beloved city. Personally, I offer my support and my prayers for all those who have died and for their loved ones. I know that I will be joined in that prayer and support by all the Catholic community. Our churches are open in the city as places of oasis – safe spaces in which people can come to pray and reflect – to remember those who have died and their families at this time." Our parish of Corpus Christi offers our prayers and condolences to the community of our neighbouring Diocese of Plymouth.

Loving and merciful Lord, we commit to your loving care those who have died,
beseeching you to receive their souls into the mercy of your love.
Comfort their loved ones who mourn and all those who are hurting.
Enable them to meet the lonely and painful days ahead in the strength of your love.
Let us not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. **Amen**

AFGHANISTAN - PRAY FOR PEACE Hours before the Taliban took control of Afghanistan's capital, Kabul, Pope Francis expressed his hope for the peace and safety of the country's citizens. **"I join in the unanimous concern for the situation in Afghanistan. I ask all of you to pray with me to the God of peace, so that the clamour of weapons might cease and solutions can be found at the table of dialogue,"** the Pope said during his Angelus address. "Only through dialogue," he added, "can the battered population of that country—men, women, elderly and children — return to their own homes, and live in peace and security, in total mutual respect." *VATICAN CITY (CNS)*

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS Completion of 'CONFIRMATION OF RELIGIOUS PRACTICE' or 'SIF' Form

OUR PROCEDURE for members of CORPUS CHRISTI PARISH: To have a Religious Practice form signed by a priest:

1. **Complete the SIF form (Please tick the appropriate attendance box and contact details)**
2. Write a **SEPARATE COVERING LETTER** (include your telephone number) stating your regularity to **WEEKEND Mass**, how long you have worshipped at Corpus Christi, & any other involvement in the church. **Please be as honest and open as possible.**
3. Put both the form & covering letter in an envelope & post through the door of Parish Office, No:18 St James Square.

OUT OF COURTESY, PLEASE DO NOT ASK ANY PRIEST DIRECTLY TO SIGN A FORM.

RETURN OF ALL FORMS: If the form is correct and has a covering letter it will be offered to the Parish Priest for signing. Once processed, parents will be contacted to come and pick it up from the Parish Office to take directly to the school.

(SECONDARY SCHOOL FORMS closing date is 31st October 2021 Please do not leave it to the last minute, as forms will not be signed on the day & may take up to a week to get it signed, stamped and back to you. Parish Administrator)
