"The readings today remind us that we are asked to worship God. Jesus said of the Pharisees "This people honour me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me" Hence their worship was hollow and empty. We need God's help in order to give God the kind of worship that will honour God and transform our lives.

First reading (Deuteronomy 4:1-2, 6-8) Moses urges the people to be faithful to God's law, which is not a burden to be endured but a source of life and wisdom.

Second reading (James 1:17-18, 21-22, 27) It is not enough to listen to the word of God, we must put it into practice.

Gospel (Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23) Jesus tells the Pharisees that they have substituted their own laws for the word of God.

Today's readings are reminding us that we must strive to have a good heart. A good heart is the source of good things. Jesus wants a heart that is humble; a heart that knows its own limitation; a heart that is ready to accept change when change is called for; a heart that is, in fact, like unto his own. He calls us to be "gentle and humble in heart".

We welcome back the staff and pupils of our Parish school. We pray for pupils who are beginning a new term in a new school.

Next Sunday (5th September) we will resume our Sunday evening Mass at 5.00pm. The following Sunday we hope to welcome back our Altar Servers. ***Thank you for all your prayers and support.*** **Fr Adrian.**

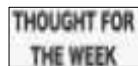
POPE FRANCIS URGES PEOPLE TO GET VACCINATED AGAINST COVID-19 The Pope has joined his voice to those of Bishops across North and South America to urge people to get jabbed against Covid-19. In a video message produced in conjunction with the Ad Council, Pope Francis praised the work of researchers and scientists in producing safe and effective Covid-19 vaccines. "Thanks to God's grace and to the work of many, we now have vaccines to protect us from Covid-19," he said in the video released recently. He added that vaccines "bring hope to end the pandemic, but only if they are available to all and if we collaborate with one another." "Vaccination is an act of love Pope Francis went on to say that getting a Covid jab that is "authorized by the respective authorities" is an "act of love." "Helping other do the same, he said, is also an act of love. "Love for oneself, love for our families and friends, and love for all peoples. Love is also social and political. "The Pope noted that social and political love is built up through "small, individual gestures capable of transforming and improving societies." "Getting vaccinated is a simple yet profound way to care for one another, especially the most vulnerable," he said. Pope Francis then prayed to God that "each one of us can make his or her own small gesture of love." **"No matter how small, love is always grand,"** he said. SCHOOL ADMISSIONS Completion of 'CONFIRMATION OF RELIGIOUS PRACTICE' or 'SIF' Form

OUR PROCEDURE for members of CORPUS CHRISTI PARISH: To have a Religious Practice form signed by a priest:

1. **Complete the SIF form (Please tick the appropriate attendance box and contact details)**
2. Write a **SEPARATE COVERING LETTER** (include your telephone number) stating your regularity to **WEEKEND Mass**, how long you have worshipped at Corpus Christi, & any other involvement in the church. **Please be as honest and open as possible.**
3. Put both the form & covering letter in an envelope & post through the door of Parish Office, No:18 St James Square.

OUT OF COURTESY, PLEASE DO NOT ASK ANY PRIEST DIRECTLY TO SIGN A FORM.

RETURN OF ALL FORMS: If the form is correct and has a covering letter it will be offered to the Parish Priest for signing. Once processed, parents will be contacted to come and pick it up from the Parish Office to take directly to the school.

(SECONDARY SCHOOL FORMS closing date is 31st October 2021 Please do not leave it to the last minute, as forms will not be signed on the day & may take up to a week to get it signed, stamped and back to you. Parish Administrator)
