"First reading (Isaiah 53: 10-11) The servant of the Lord takes on himself, the sins of His people, and thus becomes a source of blessings for many.

Second reading (Hebrews 4: 14-16) With Jesus as our high priest we can approach him with confidence because he knows our weaknesses and was like us in all things except sin.

Gospel (Mark 10: 35-45) Jesus is the suffering servant who gave his life in humble service of His people.

In the Gospel we see how far the apostles are from the spirit of self sacrifice. James and John want the top places in Jesus' kingdom. Obviously they thought that His kingdom would be modelled on worldly kingdoms, where those in high places enjoy honour, power and glory. Jesus came among us not to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many. Authority in his Church must wear the unmistakable livery of service."

**'CONFIRMATION OF RELIGIOUS PRACTICE' or 'SIF' Form**

**OUR PROCEDURE** for members of **CORPUS CHRISTI PARISH:** To have a Religious Practice form signed by a priest:

1. **Complete the SIF form (Please tick the appropriate attendance box and contact details)**
2. Write a **SEPARATE COVERING LETTER** (include your telephone number) stating your regularity to **WEEKEND Mass**, how long you have worshipped at Corpus Christi, & any other involvement in the church. **Please be as honest and open as possible.**
3. Put both the form & covering letter in an envelope & post through the door of Parish Office, No:18 St James Square.

**OUT OF COURTESY, PLEASE DO NOT ASK ANY PRIEST DIRECTLY TO SIGN A FORM.**

**RETURN OF ALL FORMS:** If the form is correct and has a covering letter it will be offered to the Parish Priest for signing. Once processed, parents will be contacted to come and pick it up from the Parish Office to take directly to the school.

**(SECONDARY SCHOOL FORMS** closing date is **31st October 2021** Please do not leave it to the last minute, as forms will not be signed on the day & may take up to a week to get it signed, stamped and back to you. **Parish Administrator**)
