2nd Sunday of LENT Year C - 13th March 2022

"On Mount Tabor, Peter, James and John got a glimpse of the glory that was hidden in Jesus. Through our faith we too glimpse the glory of the risen Jesus who lives on in the Church and in each of us.

Peter, James and John were privileged to be with Jesus on two very significant occasions. One was in the Garden at Gethsemane, when they saw Jesus in his naked agony. The other was on Mount Tabor when they saw him in Godly glory. The experiences were complementary. On Mount Tabor they saw him transfigured, His divinity had broken out clearly into the open. In the Garden of Gethsemane they saw him in the agony of apprehension before the crucifixion.

First Reading (Genesis 15: 5-12, 17-18) We hear of the solemn covenant God made with Abraham which was the foundation of God's relationship with the people of Israel.

Second Reading (Philippians 3: 17 - 4:1) Paul urges his converts to remain faithful to Christ.

Gospel (Luke 9: 28-30) The Transfiguration of Jesus on Mount Tabor.

On our journey towards Jesus Christ, and our journey through Lent, we will experience the Way of the Cross and the wounded, battered and crucified Christ but we must always remember that it leads to Glory, Resurrection and a new life. Our Lenten journey is a journey of grace and hope. We see signs of hope and brightness in the faith of people we meet in the brighter days, in Spring flowers, in the generosity of service of so many in the parish.

Please continue to pray for our Confirmation Candidates and their sponsors and families and this week we pray for our children who will be meeting the healing Christ in the Sacrament of Reconciliation this coming Saturday and for their families." **Fr Adrian**

CHURCH IN EUROPE PRAYS FOR PEACE IN UKRAINE AND FOR THE VICTIMS OF COVID
EVERY NATION CELEBRATES HOLY MASS ON A DAY DURING LENT

The Church in Europe is gathering around the Eucharistic table. From Ash Wednesday, and throughout Lent, the Bishops' Conferences of our continent will celebrate Holy Mass to invoke peace and to pray for those who have died as a result of war and of Covid. The European bishops joined Pope Francis' appeal "to make 2 March, Ash Wednesday, a Day of Fasting for Peace. I encourage believers in a special way to dedicate themselves intensely to prayer and fasting on that day.

"We wish to unite our voice", affirms H. E. Monsignor Gintaras Grušas, Archbishop of Vilnius and CCEE President, "to that of the Pope in calling for a halt to weapons, an immediate end to the war in Ukraine and for work towards peace:" The reasons for peace are stronger than any calculation of special interests and any reliance on the use of weapons."

This time of Lent is also an opportunity to reaffirm the Church's closeness to those who have suffered, and are still struggling, with the coronavirus, to call for an end to the pandemic and, during Holy Mass, to remember the victims of Covid – the many victims. The initiative includes all the Bishops' Conferences of Europe and will see, as last year, each national Bishops' Conference involved in organising at least one Mass. This is intended to be a sign of communion and hope for the entire continent; a time for fasting and prayer "to feel like brothers and sisters and to implore God to end the war."

In England and Wales, a special Mass will be celebrated by the General Secretary of the Bishops' Conference, Canon Christopher Thomas, on Wednesday, 16 March 2022. <https://www.cbcew.org.uk/>
