NEWSLETTER BAPTISM OF THE LORD Year C 9th January 2022 THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD The Baptism of Jesus marked a profound change to his way of life. He began his public ministry in the power of the Holy Spirit to proclaim the Good News to those who were poor. In the opening verse of today's Gospel, John the Baptist makes it clear to the people, who were beginning to think he might be the Christ, that Jesus is superior to him and that the baptism Jesus will give, with the Holy Spirit and with fire, is superior to John's baptism with water. After Jesus's own baptism we hear then how the heavens opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon him and a voice came from Heaven "This is my Son, the Beloved, my favour rests on him". In our Baptism we are made, by adoption, children of God. God's favour rests on us. First reading (40:1-5, 9-11) People are urged to prepare a way for the Lord who is coming to save them. Second reading (Titus 2:11-14; 3:4-7) God's grace and love are manifested in Jesus Christ, Gospel (Luke 3:15-16, 21-22) The Baptism of Jesus.
