4th Sunday of LENT Year C - 27th March 2022



"Fourth Sunday of Lent is 'Laetare Sunday' - meaning "rejoice". Vestment colours are pink or rose today. First Reading (Joshua 5: 9-12) The Israelites, free at last from the humiliation they suffered in Egypt, enter the land of promise and partake of the produce.

Second Reading (2 Corinthians 5: 17 -21) Christ brought about a reconciliation between God and humanity. The task of the Church is to proclaim the benefits of this to all people.

Gospel (Luke 15: 1-3, 11-32) The parable of the prodigal son reminds us that God delights in showing mercy to repentant sinners.

The theme of today's readings is God's mercy to sinners. In the first reading we have the beautiful words of God spoken to his people "I have take the shame of Egypt away from you". The years of wandering in the desert are over, they are coming home to the promised land. The second reading stresses how God has reconciled us to himself through Christ, not holding our faults against us.

This reminds us of the home coming of the Prodigal Son. His shame is left behind. His years of wandering are over. He returns home to a welcome and a feast of rejoicing.

We welcome the Corpus Christi School Choir, who are providing music at the 10am Sunday Mass.

We also welcome some of our children who will be making their First Holy Communion this May and their families. The children will be presented to the parish at the beginning of Mass. The rest of the children will be welcomed next Sunday.

We were to welcome our Jesuit Provincial, Fr Damien Howard SJ, this weekend but he has had to delay his visit.

Happy Mothering Sunday. We pray for all Mothers on this special day." Fr Adrian
