PALM SUNDAY & EASTER Year C - 10th & 17th April 2022 "Today we start the most important week in the Church year. Holy Week. This week we remind ourselves of Gods generous love of us and we thank God for sending Jesus Christ to us. He identifies with us in our humanity and shows the Way, the Truth and the Light. On Palm Sunday we are told of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem as a messianic King, this is a sign that the peace and				
salvation decreed by God is at hand. First Reading: (Isaiah 50: 4-7) The prophet suffers in carrying out his mission but is confident that God will vindicate him. Second Reading: (Philippians 2:6-11) Because Jesus took on himself our human condition and accepted death on a cross, the Father has made him Lord of Heaven and Earth. Gospel (Luke 22: 14-23:50) St Luke's version of God's great love for us, shown in the Passion of Jesus Christ.				
On Holy Thursday (Maundy Thursday) - we rejoice in the gift of the Eucharist at the Last Supper. On Good Friday - we remind ourselves again of the love that Christ has for us in his Passion and death on the Cross. On Holy Saturday - the liturgy tells us of the history of God's love and care for us. We hear the readings about Gods action in our world and we rejoice in starting our life as Christians in our Baptism and we bless the water and renew our Baptismal promises. We remember all those being received into the Church this Easter. Easter Sunday - Christ is Risen - We are an Easter people.
