FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER Year C - 8th May 2022

"In today's Gospel, Jesus, the Good Shepherd, says to us "I know my sheep. They listen to my voice and follow me'

First Reading (Acts 13: 14,43-52) Paul and Barnabas preach the Gospel, firstly to the Jews but they reject it; then they preach it to the gentiles.

Second Reading (Apoc 7: 9, 14-17) A vision of those who came through times of persecution to share in Christ's glory in Heaven.

Gospel (John 10: 27-30) Jesus, the Good Shepherd, will not allow anyone to snatch from his care, the sheep the Father has given him.

The feeling of belonging to Jesus, and of being known and loved by him, is enormously comforting and reassuring. How can we tell if we truly belong to his flock? What does belonging entail? Firstly it is to believe in him. Secondly is to listen to Christ speaking to us and thirdly is to follow him

This Sunday we are asked to pray especially for Vocations to the Priesthood or Religious life. We also pray for our own deepening of our commitment to serve, an openness to Christ's call, a generosity to serve God in each other. We, all of us, are called by God to believe, listen and follow.

Let us pray for our Parish, our Diocese and for the work of the Handmaids of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and for the Society of Jesus. May the Lord lead followers to his vineyard.

I am very grateful to the people in the Portsmouth Diocese who have welcomed and received me so kindly into their parishes over these years... My ordination date, please God, has been confirmed for Saturday 16 July, at 11am in St John's Cathedral, Portsmouth. If you are able to come, you would be very welcome... this is not just for myself but for the whole Church. Please pray for me in these coming months as I will continue to pray for you.' 
