DOUBLE NEWSLETTER SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER & PENTECOST Year C - 29th May & 5th June 2022

FR ADRIAN RETIRING "A number of you will be aware that your parish priest Fr Adrian has now passed his 75th birthday. He has been parish priest here for the last six years and shepherded your community through all the challenges and difficulties of the pandemic. I think, by the way, that he has done a great job. It is now time for him to relinquish the role of leadership,..... So the first thing to say is a big thank you to him. I am delighted to be able to say that the Bishop of Portsmouth has assured me that he will be able to provide a parish priest from his clergy to replace Fr Adrian. He (Bishop Philip) writes "There is no doubt that we owe a great debt of gratitude to Fr Adrian and our Jesuit brothers who have shepherded the parish of Corpus Christi, Boscombe so well for so long. It is with sadness that we receive the news that they no longer have the capacity to staff this beloved Catholic community following a period of 125 years. The religious order will end its administration of the parish in September. I have appointed a new parish priest, who will take up their post from 8th September 2022. and I will announce who this will be in the summer, as part of the diocesan clergy moves. The current pastor Jesuit, Fr Adrian, will help facilitate the transition, I ask you to pray for Fr Adrian and our Jesuit brothers in their future mission."

... Our Jesuit community will continue to live in the nearby care facility for our older men, and I know that the Jesuits will be on hand to celebrate Mass, as much as is helpful to the new parish priest.... On behalf of all the Jesuits who have lived here and served you over so many years, I want to say a heartfelt thank you and to assure you all of our prayers and our love" Fr Damian Howard SJ, the Jesuit Provincial.

SUNDAY OBLIGATION "Since the beginning of the Covid pandemic, until the present time, we have shared with you our judgment that the situation of the last two years has meant that the Sunday Obligation has been impeded and has needed to be fulfilled in other ways. We thank God that this situation has now changed. The pressing challenges of the pandemic have lessened significantly. Most people have resumed the wide range of normal activities, no longer restricted by the previous Covid measures. We therefore believe that the reasons which have prevented Catholics from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation no longer apply. We understand there will still be some members of our congregations who, for reasons of health, do not feel safe enough to return to Mass. It has always been the understanding of the Church that when the freedom of any Catholic to attend Mass in person is impeded for a serious reason, because of situations such as ill health, care for the sick or legitimate fear, this is not a breach of the Sunday Obligation.

Looking forward to the forthcoming feast of Pentecost, we now invite all Catholics who have not yet done so to return to attending Mass in person. We are grateful to our clergy, religious and lay faithful who have served our parishes, schools and communities with dedication and distinction throughout this pandemic.
