**MOST HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY Year C - 12th June 2022**

This feast day brings us face to face with the mystery of God. We can know certain things about God by looking at Creation. But it is Jesus who reveals to us the Mystery of God.

Lord Jesus you reveal God to us as a Father who cares for his children.

Through the incarnation you have become a Brother to us

Through the Holy Spirit, the love of God has been poured into our hearts.

First Reading (Proverbs 8: 22-31) A reading in praise of the Wisdom of God which can be seen as a grasping towards the revelation of the mystery of the Trinity.

Second Reading (Romans 5: 1-5) Christ made it possible for us a relationship of love with God. This gives us hope and sustains us in times of suffering. The Holy Spirit helps us to recognise God's love for us.

Gospel (John 16: 12-15) The Holy Spirit helps the church to grasp the full meaning of all that Jesus said, especially what he said about the Father.

The mystery of the Trinity is not something to argue about or even study. It is something to pray about and to live. The Christian lives in the world of the Father, the Son and the Spirit.

The Diocese of Portsmouth will in September be providing a new Parish Priest, **Monsignor John Nelson**, to serve Corpus Christi Parish.
