"Jesus sends out his disciples as bearers of peace, healing and the good news of salvation to others. We are asked to do the same.

First Reading (Isaiah 60:10-14) A picture of the blessings God will bestow on Jerusalem and its inhabitants.

Second Reading (Galatian 6: 14-18) St Paul insists that the Christian life means becoming like Christ. He himself bears the marks of Christ's Passion on his body.

Gospel (Luke 10: 1-12, 17-20) The sending out of seventy two disciples.

Peace is not a negative thing. It is not just the absence of war or enmity. It is a positive thing. It implies openness, friendship, tolerance, good will, hospitality and reconciliation and forgiveness.

We come to mass to receive blessings from the Lord, to receive the Eucharist. We are sent out from Mass having received the peace of Christ and the Eucharist to be ambassadors of peace to others.

Thank you and good luck. Sister Maria of the Handmaids of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is leaving our parish this afternoon to her new assignment in Portugal. **We will be having refreshments after 10.00am Mass today in the Parish Centre to say farewell and wish her good luck in the future.**

We thank her for all she has done in the Parish in so many different ways but above all we thank her for the cheerful witness she gives - she exudes the Peace of the Lord!
