NEWSLETTER 15th Sunday of Year C - 10th July 2022

"Today in the Gospel reading we read of the great story of the Good Samaritan. In this parable Jesus tells us that God wants us to care for each other. The Priest and the Levite stand condemned for their sin, a sin not of commission but of omission. They passed by and refused to help the man who was in need.

Jesus is the Good Samaritan, he heals us and binds up our wounds.

First Reading (Deut 30:10-14) Moses urges the people to obey the law.

Second Reading (Colossians 1: 15-20) St Paul emphasises the supremacy of Christ "all things were created through Christ and for him"

Gospel (Luke 10:25-37) The Good Samaritan parable.

The Ten commandments were proclaimed to remind the Israelites of their special relationship with God as a chosen people. We are called and chosen in our baptism and the commandments remind us of that. The first three commandments are about us and God and the rest are about us and our neighbours. All the commandments are reminding us of God's love for us and how we should love in return. Jesus reminds us that the real question is not who do I consider to be my neighbour but who am I willing to treat as a neighbour? Our neighbour is anyone, regardless of clan, colour, race or creed who needs our help.

We are getting ready to welcome Monsignor John Nelson as Parish Priest in September as the Diocese of Portsmouth takes over the care of the Parish. I am going to St Wilfred's, 1 Winckley Square, Preston PR1 3JJ

Fr Hugh and the SJ Community will still be here supporting Fr John and the parish. " Fr Adrian
