**16th Sunday of Year C - 17th July 2022**

"Jesus came to Martha and Mary's house. Martha got completely carried away by details of hospitality but Mary sat at his feet and listened to him. At Mass we have an opportunity to do what Mary did, namely spend some time in the presence of the Lord.

First Reading (Genesis 18: 1-10) When Abraham gave hospitality to three strangers he did not know he was entertaining God himself, who would reward him with good news.

Second Reading (Col 1: 24-28) St Paul, a minister of the good news of the calling of the Gentiles to salvation, suffers for his converts.

Gospel (Luke 10: 38-42) The contrast between Martha's activity and Mary's quiet listening to the Lord. If we could spend some quiet time with God, our lives would be calmer, less driven by anxiety and worry. Action and contemplation are not meant to be contrasted, both are necessary and have to be part of our lives.

Monsignor John Nelson will be here as Parish Priest in September as the Diocese of Portsmouth takes over the care of the Parish. I am going to St Wilfred's, 1 Winckley Square, Preston PR1 3JJ. Fr Hugh and the SJ Community will still be here supporting Fr John and the parish. "Fr Adrian
