**17th Sunday of Year C - 24th July 2022**

“ASK, SEEK, KNOCK. Jesus says to us what he said to his disciples “Ask and you will receive; Seek and you will find; Knock and the door will be opened to you”

First Reading (Genesis 18: 20-32) Abraham interceded with God on behalf of Sodom, a city full of evil.

Second Reading (Colossians 2: 12-14) Through baptism a Christian dies to the old way of life and rises to new life in Christ.

Gospel (Luke 11: 1-13) Jesus urges the disciples to pray to God with trust for all their spiritual and temporal needs.

The ‘Our Father’ is the first and greatest of all Christian prayers. Its short and simple phrases embrace every relation between us and God. It not only tells us what to pray for but also how to pray.

The first part deals with God. We acknowledge and praise God - we pray for the coming of his kingdom. We pray that his will be done on Earth.

The second part deals with us and our needs. We pray for our needs, we pray for forgiveness of our sins and the grace to be able to forgive others.
