## 22nd Sunday of Year C - 28th August 2022

"First Reading (Ecclesiasticus 3:17-20. 28-29) There is praise for the person who is humble.

Second Reading (Hebrews 12: 18-19, 22-24) This reading contrasts Mount Sinai, where the old covenant was made, and Mount Zion, which stands for the heavenly Jerusalem.

Gospel (Luke 14: 1, 7-14) Jesus urges his followers not to covert places of honour, and to act out of unselfish motives. The readings show the importance of humility. The first reading praises the person who is humble. A humble person is aware of his own weakness and never rejects wisdom, no matter where it comes from.

So we are called to listen to the invitation from Christ and accept it. We are called to prepare by recognising our gifts and talents and use them in service of God and neighbours. In other words, we love and we serve." Fr Adrian

**OUR PROCEDURE for members of CORPUS CHRISTI PARISH:** To have a Religious Practice form signed by a priest:

1. **Complete the SIF form (Please tick the appropriate attendance box and contact details)**
2. Write a **SEPARATE COVERING LETTER** (include your **telephone number**) stating your regularity to **WEEKEND Mass**, how long you have worshipped at Corpus Christi, & any other involvement in the church. **Please be as honest and open as possible.**
3. Put both the form & covering letter in an envelope & post through the door of Parish Office, No:18 St James Square.

**OUT OF COURTESY, PLEASE DO NOT ASK ANY PRIEST DIRECTLY TO SIGN A FORM.**

**RETURN OF ALL FORMS:** If the form is correct and has a covering letter it will be offered to the Parish Priest for signing. Once processed, parents will be contacted to come and pick it up from the Parish Office to take directly to the school.

(SECONDARY SCHOOL FORMS closing date **31st October 2022** Please do not leave it to the last minute especially as we will have a new Priest and the **Parish Office will be closed 30th Sept until Friday 14th Oct (inc).
