

It is with deep sorrow and grief that Bishop Philip Egan learnt of the death of Queen Elizabeth II. Bishop Egan said: "A woman of faith, service, and duty: We remember Queen Elizabeth II in our prayers and offer up thanks to God for a woman who served the people of our kingdom tirelessly for over seventy years. We pray for the repose of her soul & that the Father receive her into His Eternal Kingdom. Our prayers & thoughts are with the royal family at this sad time"

In her official role as 'Defender of the Faith and Supreme Governor of the Church of England', the Queen, through her words and actions, always showed herself to be a woman of a deep Christian faith. Throughout her reign Queen Elizabeth II also ensured a relationship of mutual respect between the Church of England and the Catholic Church.

- 1. Complete the SIF form (Please tick the appropriate attendance box and contact details)
- Write a <u>SEPARATE COVERING LETTER</u> (include your telephone number) stating your regularity to WEEKEND
 Mass, how long you have worshipped at Corpus Christi, & any other involvement in the church.
 Please be as honest and open as possible.
- 3. Put both the form & covering letter in an envelope & post through the door of Parish Office, No:18 St James Square.

OUT OF COURTESY, PLEASE DO NOT ASK ANY PRIEST DIRECTLY TO SIGN A FORM.

RETURN OF ALL FORMS: If the form is correct and has a covering letter it will be offered to the Parish Priest for signing. Once processed, parents will be contacted to come and pick it up from the Parish Office to take directly to the school.
