Back in the time when +Derek Worlock was Bishop of Portsmouth, soon after the Second Vatican Council, he attended a conference in Rome and found himself seated next to a very young Bishop, Paul Verdzekov from Cameroon. Both had recently been ordained as Bishops, in quite different dioceses, but with a shared understanding of how connections should be made way beyond their local dioceses. Because Bamenda was in the English-speaking part of Cameroon (most is French-speaking) and the climate is manageable for people from England, a link was created and our twin arrangement was born.

Since then, a number of priests have worked in Bamenda, and more recently priests have come from there to work in our parishes. But this exchange is only one part of the link. Through the generosity and commitment of parishioners across our diocese we have been able to support life-changing and life-enhancing projects in Cameroon to improve health facilities, provide education centres and groups for youths, and facilities where those wishing to learn more about the faith can gather. In short, your contributions have changed lives.

This weekend is BAMENDA SUNDAY and as we pray for the people of our sister Diocese we also have the opportunity to continue our practical support for them through a Second Collection. Please contribute if you are in a position to do so. Fr John

A SECOND COLLECTION FOR BAMENDA will be taken this weekend. Our diocese is twinned with Bamenda, the capital of North West Province in Cameroon, West Africa.

In the latest newsletter it states" Conditions remain very challenging for the people of Bamenda, where many are said to be subsisting on just £1 per day, making it nigh on impossible for them to meet school fees for their children to be educated nor medical fees, should their health be suffering.

The situation has been exacerbated by the pandemic and the ongoing conflict. As rural schools were forced to close in the early days of the conflict and people fled their homes to seek shelter in the relative safety of the city, the strain on resources in Bamenda city has increased with the influx of IDPs (Internally Displaced Persons).

In these circumstances, people naturally turn to the Church to help them. The Archbishop's Education Fund helps orphans and vulnerable children to meet the costs of attending primary school. A standing order for £6 per month would help us support one child's grant." Please be generous, every little helps.

<u>GOD'S NAME 'CANNOT BLESS TERROR AND VIOLENCE'</u> Recently Pope Francis reiterates that religions cannot be used for war, and calls for nations to defuse conflicts with the weapon of dialogue. This was the appeal of Pope Francis, along with Heads of State, religious leaders, and various high-ranking authorities, during the closing ceremony of the annual 'Spirit of Assisi' prayer for peace at Rome's iconic Colosseum. This year held under the theme "The Cry for Peace" "Religions cannot be used for war. Only peace is holy, and no one is to use the name of God to bless terror and violence. If

you see wars around you, do not resign yourselves! The peoples desire peace."

Pope Francis said this year's prayer for peace holds a special importance. "This year our prayer has become a heartfelt plea," he said, "because today peace has been gravely violated, assaulted and trampled upon, and this in Europe, on the very continent that in the last century endured the horrors of two World Wars." Sadly, since then, the Pope lamented, wars have continued to cause bloodshed and to impoverish the earth.
