FOURTH SUNDAY of LENT - Year A 19th March 2023

Do I give what is right, or what is left? As a Parish Priest, I have been very fortunate in each of the places I have served, to find in place a Parish Finance Committee made up of committed and competent parishioners. As a priest, it is a relief to know that the practical side of parish life is being carefully managed. Here at Corpus Christi we have such a Committee which continues to do a valuable job in monitoring our income and expenditure. Overall, I'm pleased to say this parish is not in

debt (many are). However, as you'll hear me explain this weekend, we do have substantial bills on the near horizon and generally the costs of running the parish are only going in one direction: up! This is no different from what all families and households are facing these days but it would be remiss of me not to share with you our financial position as a parish – and ask for your help. This could come in a variety of ways.

Attached to this Newsletter you will find a summary (what we submit to the diocese each year is far more detailed) but it gives you a snapshot of what happened in a twelve month period to the end of August 2022 (which is when our financial year ended). It shows a small surplus. But it also highlights a number of other things, not least of which is the amount being given which is not Gift Aided. For taxpayers, this is the easiest way to increase the value of your offerings. So, you will also find with this Newsletter a sheet outlining points I'd ask you to consider.

What we are able to do as a parish, both in looking after the buildings handed on to us, as well as building up the community at Corpus Christi and reaching out to the wider world, all comes down to what you are prepared to fund through the Offertory. Father John

CAFD - Lent Family Fast Day Thank you for your Offerings following the Fast Day we observed on 3 March. The Parish is able to forward to CAFOD £1280. To this will be added £178.50 in Gift Aid giving a total of £1458.50 which is a magnificent contribution. This helps support CAFOD's work in a number of countries and is a sign of our willingness to reach out to those who are facing enormous challenges and difficulties.

THE CLERGY ASSISTANCE FUND This weekend there is a second collection for the Clergy Assistance Fund, which contributes to the work of the Department for Clergy Team. The Department for Clergy exists to provide care and support for the ordained in our Diocese. The Diocese of Portsmouth is responsible for supporting the diocesan clergy in active ministry including from religious orders, and those in retirement, who with dedication and care, serve our parishes, chaplaincies, schools, outreach and mission: bringing people closer to Jesus Christ through His Church. This appeal resources our Diocese to assist our priests towards holiness, happiness and health - to serve those who serve us, by looking after the welfare, ongoing formation & personal support of our clergy, such as the provision of spiritual direction, counselling, appraisal, ongoing formation and practical advice. It organises retreats, ministerial formation days, courses/sabbaticals. It looks after the junior clergy, the overseas clergy & especially the retired clergy. It is the principal mechanism through which the Bishop looks after the wellbeing of the clergy.
