THE FEAST OF PENTECOST

Next weekend, in Portsmouth at the Cathedral, thirteen young people from Corpus Christi Parish will be confirmed by Bishop Philip alongside others from various parts of the diocese. Already baptised, and having received the Eucharist, this Sacrament completes the process by which they become full members of the Church.

Something we have considered in our meetings are the gifts that God's Holy Spirit pours into us, not measured out in a miserly manner but with generosity. Those seven gifts are listed as: wisdom; understanding; counsel; fortitude; knowledge; piety; fear of the Lord.

As a result of receiving those gifts of the Holy Spirit, it becomes possible for us to live our lives in a different way, 'producing the goods' if you like. The Church lists twelve 'Fruits of the Spirit' which are: love; joy; peace; patience; kindness; goodness; generosity; gentleness; faithfulness; modesty; self-control; chastity.

Many of us were confirmed quite some years ago. The Feast of Pentecost gives us a golden opportunity to open our hearts, our minds, our whole beings to receive once again the gifts God wants us to have. Then, infused with those gifts, we commit anew to producing the fruits. As Jesus makes it clear to his friends: 'people will know that you are my disciples if you love one another'. In other words, it isn't what we say – it's what we do that matters. Father John

These unique gatherings will reflect on the importance and dignity of the human person and introduce new areas of study and stories, including issues surrounding disability.
