GIVING THANKS On Friday 7 July Father Denis Blackledge SJ celebrates his Golden Jubilee. Fifty years ago, he was ordained priest and, as most of you know, a good ten years of that was spent as Parish Priest here at Corpus Christi. It is right and proper that we join with him in thanking God for all that He has done through Father Denis' ministry. Therefore, next Sunday, 9 July, he will preside and

preach at our 10am Mass and afterwards there will be a simple Reception in the Parish Hall [drinks, nibbles, etc). So, please come and join us for the Mass and then come to the Hall for a less formal celebration.

In other news, you may have noticed two small changes in the church. The first concerns the statue of St Anthony which has now been secured on a stand near the rear door of the church. For some time it has been standing in the nearby chapel as we needed to work out how to fix it so that it did not present a risk. The last thing we would want was for the statue to topple on someone praying below! The second is the beautiful panel depicting a number of martyrs which has been hidden from sight behind the Mary Organ. It is now on the wall next to the Lady Chapel. I plan to produce a card which details who is represented on the plaque as it isn't easy to read the writing from floor level. It is a significant work of art and I think it deserves to be seen rather than tucked away. Father John
