## 14th Sunday Year A 9th July 2023

SUMMERTIME Someone commented to me last week that "now the nights are drawing in" we have winter to look forward to! There's always a merchant of gloom available when you don't need one. Technically what he said was correct: once past the 21 June (the 'longest day') the evenings do begin to shorten little by little. At Wimbledon officials monitor the decreasing light which means by 9pm play needs to be suspended until the following day. But to me it feels as though we have barely begun summer weather and there is still the prospect of school holidays and, perhaps, time away or with family over the coming months. So, let's not jump ahead too quickly but rather make the most of it.

This is the fifth Parish where I've worked in the diocese [Newbury, Abingdon, Reading and Eastleigh being the others]. None of those had the feel of a holiday destination and of course none were on the coast. Having arrived last September to be told that summer 2022 had been a fantastic one, I was looking forward to the different feel of living here. It hasn't disappointed. Being able to walk along the top paths, or below near the beach, costs nothing and brightens my day seeing families and groups relaxing and enjoying themselves. Barbecues are on the go and there is generally a happy atmosphere. You might see the odd person collapsed with shock at the price of an ice cream (!) but on the whole it's a great place to be. I'm a relatively new arrival. I wonder whether, once you've lived here for a number of years, you start to take it for granted.

This can apply to so many things in life: family, friends, a job, a home, care when you need it. As part and parcel of daily life they can easily be taken for granted. Perhaps we should stop now and then, look around, and simply appreciate what we Father John have.



SEA SUNDAY Seafarers and fishers play a vital role in all of our lives, but they often work in difficult, hazardous conditions. In the last year, more crews have been abandoned by their employers than ever before. Many are still being denied the right to leave their ships for even a short break away from the relentless noise and pressure onboard. Many are reporting more stress and poorer mental health.

Sea Sunday is Sunday 9th July (our second collection for Sea Sunday will be next Sunday, 16th July). It is when the Church prays for all those who live and work at sea. Your support will make a big difference to seafarers and fishers in need. You can donate

A RECENT STORY highlighting how Stella Maris' work, supported by your prayers and generosity, can make a huge difference. A ship arrived at Teesport in North East England last year with 22 seafarers on board. Two Stella Maris ship visitors conducted a routine visit, taking with them welcome packs and bags of clothing. It transpired that the crew was under huge mental and physical strain.

One confided that, during the voyage to Teesport from the USA, he had only been getting two hours sleep a night because he was so stressed and overworked. He was also concerned that the crew were no longer able to operate the vessel safely as they were all exhausted. The Stella Maris team contacted the relevant authorities and a vessel detention notice was served that afternoon. As a result, the seafarers were able to go ashore for the first time in many months and spent time relaxing at the seafarers' centre in the port. 11 of the crew were repatriated to the Philippines later that month.

Stella Maris' ship visiting can only happen because of your support - your generosity helps its chaplains and volunteers to support over 137,000 seafarers in ports around the UK and to reach 70,000 ships around the world.
