THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN In the coming weeks our Sunday Gospel passages focus on 'The Kingdom of Heaven'. Nowhere does Jesus ever give a precise definition but instead he uses a series of parables each of which shed light on what he means when speaking of the Kingdom. It is impossible to pin down, but that doesn't mean we can't understand and gradually piece together what Jesus is talking about. For example, there are times when he speaks of The Kingdom as already here; on other occasions its establishment seems to be some way in the distance. Often his teaching is about this Kingdom growing and spreading. It is definitely not about territory or dominance. So, as we listen to the Gospel today and the coming Sundays, it is worth keeping in mind one question: 'what does this add to my understanding of The Kingdom of Heaven'? Bit by bit we build a picture and are drawn into what Jesus puts at the heart of his teaching ministry.

August in Lisbon, Portugal. "Mary arose and went with haste" (Lk 1:39) is the bible quote chosen by Pope Francis as the motto of the World Youth Day. Addressing young people in particular, and challenging them to be courageous missionaries, the following was written by the Pope in the Apostolic Exhortation Christus Vivit: "Where does Jesus send us? There are no borders, no limits: he sends us everywhere. The Gospel is for everyone, not just for some".
