GROWING TOGETHER IN FAITH Last weekend I asked you to mull over a question: 'do I want to deepen my faith – or do I feel things are fine as they are?' Faith is a very personal part of who we are but at the same time it is a force, a reality, which we have in common with others. To develop our faith, on our own we can use books or DVDs which address subjects at the heart of the Christian journey. But for many of us it is of greater benefit if we do this with other people. Why? Because by sharing and discussing we feed each other as we are at different stages of the same journey.

Talking of feeding, I believe that one of the best ways to come together is by sharing a meal. It doesn't need to be 5* dining – simple is often best. It hasn't escaped my notice that in our parish we have many cultures and nationalities represented so this could also be an interesting way to sample the richness of our community.

If we are to form some groups to enable people to come together to explore our faith, then I think it would be good to provide some options in terms of times (you'll never find a day or time to suit everyone so a few groups spread through the week is better). We can put together a framework which works for people and fits into lives which are, I know, already busy. But this is really worth doing because, if we deepen our own faith, we will be much better equipped to share it with others. What we have is too good to keep to ourselves.

So, the question this week is: 'would you be interested in joining a group to discuss and learn more about our Catholic faith?'

THE POPE PRAYS FOR DROWNED MIGRANTS Pope Francis prayed for all those who recently died and added that "with sorrow and shame" we remember that almost two thousand men, women and children have already died this year at sea trying to reach Europe from North Africa.

Calling it "an open wound for humanity," the Pope encouraged political and diplomatic efforts to help heal this suffering "in a spirit of solidarity and fraternity" and with the commitment of everyone to make efforts "to prevent shipwrecks and rescue migrants."
