<u>PASTORAL LETTER FROM BISHOP PHILIP</u> This Sunday is usually designated as 'Education Sunday'. It always seems odd that this is placed just days after schools start their autumn term and so I decided to move it to next weekend, 16/17 September. The good news is that this enables pupils from Corpus Christi School to take the lead at the 10am Mass next Sunday when we will pray for the work of teachers and all staff who work with young people in our schools and colleges.

Linked to this is a Pastoral Letter issued by Bishop Philip. To allow people an opportunity to read carefully (it is not always easy to take in the contents when it is read out during Mass) we have printed copies and you will find one attached to this Newsletter. The main thrust of the Bishop's Letter is to announce the launch of the final version of the Diocesan Mission document: You Will be My Witnesses, with information on how to access this.

Next weekend there will be forms available linked to the plan to establish a number of small groups in Corpus Christi Parish. The purpose of the forms is to gauge what people might want to take part in: perhaps a Prayer Group, Bible Study Group, or discussion group on matters of faith. There is no point in me simply setting something up and then hoping parishioners will buy into it. We need to know what it is you would like to engage with as a way of deepening your faith. Please give it some thought during the coming week and look out for the Forms next weekend. I hope a good number will feel they want to take part and we can then get on and put together groups at times which work for those keen to be part of this. *Father John*

HISTORIC BEATIFICATION Today, in the Polish village of Markowa, something momentous is happening. This will be the remarkable occasion of an entire family being beatified at once, including their unborn child! Józef Ulma and his wife Wiktoria, heavily pregnant at the time of her death, sheltered families of Jews from the Nazis. They knew what it would cost them and their family if they were ever discovered, but they couldn't turn their backs on their neighbours. When the Nazis came for the Ulmas, it was the dead of night and everyone was sleeping. But the Nazis knew exactly what they would find: they had been tipped off. They didn't spare a single person inside the home - not the Jewish families, not Józef and Wiktoria, their unborn child nor their 6 children aged between 2yrs - 8yrs. After their deaths, a Bible inside their home was discovered to have the parable of the Good Samaritan underlined in red ink. They had truly lived Jesus' call to love their neighbour as themselves. The story of the Ulma family and the tragic circumstances that led to their deaths is told in a new book "No Greater Love: The Martyrdom of the Ulma Family".
