## FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT Year B - 3rd December 2023

## BEING RECONCILED WITH GOD AND ONE ANOTHER

This Advent is very short: just three weeks because the Fourth Sunday is also Christmas Eve. So, there is no time to waste if we are to benefit and make the most of the opportunities this beautiful Season in the Church's Year offers us.

Not surprisingly, children in our schools are focused on preparing to celebrate the birth of Jesus: Nativity Plays of various types are being rehearsed; older children are practising Readings and Carols to present to parents and families. The doors on Advent Calendars begin to be opened as the countdown to the 25 December gets underway. Shops ratchet up their efforts to sell anything that appears related to Christmas – or is red and green in colour! There is absolutely nothing wrong with being caught up in this excitement, even when we are at the stage where we have celebrated Christmas many times. The infectious enthusiasm of the young should be catching.

At the same time, Advent has a purpose of its own. It is one of the key seasons which focus our thoughts on 'preparation'. But not just preparation for Christmas, also being more ready for that second coming of Christ whenever it might be. Being awake, being alert and being ready, are all themes in Advent as we look at our lives and consider whether there are changes we need to make. Those may not be dramatic but who amongst us can say that we are perfect? Surely there are areas of our lives, our relationships, our approach to work, etc. which need God's forgiveness and healing to enable us to flourish, to grow and become closer to the person God intends us to be.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) can help with this. On Friday 15 December at 7pm a number of priests will be available for this within a Penitential Service. If you haven't been to this Sacrament for some time, think about coming. If you come regularly to Confession, try and join us that evening. It will be an opportunity, together, to celebrate the reconciliation and peace God wants us to have with him and with each other. That in turn will put us in a better position to welcome Jesus when Christmas comes once more. Father John
