REMEMBERING - NOT FORGETTING

During the week I was given an update on the situation in Burma (now known as Myanmar). This is a country with a troubled past and today exists under a vicious and oppressive military regime. One of those who challenged the authorities over the years is a lady called Aung San Suu Kyi but, after a brief spell when her election was recognised, she is now in prison and out of sight. It is three years since the military coup in 2021 and a group visiting the country recently witnessed the suffering of the people there. They reported that: "we crossed the border from Thailand into Karen State, Burma, to visit a camp for internally displaced people. We spoke to villagers who had to flee their homes because of airstrikes by the Burmese military, their homes burnt and left with nothing. We visited a medical centre, treating victims of military attacks, and saw the terrible injuries caused by mortar fire and landmines. The community groups running the camps and clinics are doing amazing work, but they told us about the desperate need for more resources and the lack of international support."

We sometimes hear talk of 'the news cycle'. How quickly the cameras and Reporters move on from one disaster to the next. What was a focus becomes sidelined as the next crisis takes over and dominates the media. The group visiting Burma were encouraged by the fact that people there have not lost hope – despite all their hardships. They want the world to remember their struggle, and not to lose interest. They feel frustration that governments issue warm words of support but continue to sell weapons to the military regime who use them against their own people.

For us it is hard to keep up with all that's happening in different countries. Even the war in Ukraine was edged sideways in the news when the situation in Gaza and Israel exploded last October. But we have a duty to try and know what is still happening in countries like Burma/Myanmar, Iran, Iraq, Sudan, Yemen, Libya, Afghanistan, even when they are no longer front-page news. We must keep these peoples in our prayers because that solidarity really does make a difference to those who can begin to feel they are forgotten.

PARISH MEETINGS. Please don't forget that we have two meetings arranged to which all parishioners are invited (you only need to come to one of the two as the agenda will be repeated). The first is next **Thursday 7 March**; the second is the following **Tuesday 12 March**. Both begin at 7pm (ending by 8.30pm) and will be an opportunity to begin looking at how we as Corpus Christi Parish take forward the Vision for our diocese, and also to consider the practical implications of how we make the best use of our financial resources and buildings going forward.
