FIFTH SUNDAY of LENT Year C 6th April 2025



The Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Next Thursday evening there are a number of priests joining us from the Bournemouth area. Our Lent Penitential Service begins at 7pm on Thursday 10 April. The first part focuses on God's Word and a chance to reflect on our lives. Then there is an opportunity to speak one-to-one with a priest in Confession – although not everyone does this. Many people find this way of celebrating Reconciliation helpful, and it means you can choose a priest to speak with. I do encourage everyone to come along and take part. If you decide to wait until our usual Saturday morning time for Confession, based on past experience, you could well find yourself queuing for a long time - so please take the opportunity afforded by Thursday's Service with more priests available.

In this weekend's Gospel passage from St John, we hear about the woman accused of sinning by others who thought themselves better than her. When pressed, Jesus asks them to consider whether they are in any position to make judgements or condemn her. One by one they drift away and in a moment of personal encounter, Jesus says to the woman: 'Neither do I condemn you; go, and from now on sin no more'. What an amazing thing to hear – and which is expressed in the words of absolution spoken by the priest in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Aidan Foy. I have been extremely grateful to Aidan who, since I arrived, has guided me on many issues concerning our buildings and site here at Corpus Christi. As the Facilities Manager, Aidan has ensured all inspections and certificates are in date and managed many practical issues linked to the church, presbytery and parish centre. He dealt with the groups using the centre. Now that the Parish Centre is closed, Aidan has decided to step down from this role – but remaining as Chair of the Parish Finance Committee. I would like to put on record the thanks of the parish for all he has done over a number of years. In the near future the plan is to establish a Parish Site Committee, to ensure our buildings continue to be well maintained - and consider options for the parish centre and the land it stands on.

This is very much a Polish tradition but anyone who would like to come and take part is welcome. This hasn't been included on the small calendar/card of Services in Holy Week and Easter so please make a note – and join us. We will use the liturgy I have obtained from a Polish Priest and although some Readings will be in Polish, most will be in English.
