One big 'Thank you' and two Requests!

Last Saturday morning we celebrated a special Mass at which fifty-eight children received the gift of Jesus in Holy Communion for the very first time. Dressed beautifully and full of excitement, it was easy to share their joy at this moment in their lives, this step on their journey of faith. Of course, it is a moment to remember but the important thing is that these children keep receiving Communion, week in and week out. I do want to record the thanks of everyone involved – and our parish – to Greg our Deacon who oversees the preparation programme each year and devotes so much time and energy to it. Greg will be the first to say that it is only possible because there is a great team working with him so we extend our gratitude to them too. If anyone who is not already involved would like to join in with next year's programme from the autumn, just let us know. This year the meetings were held in the church on Saturday afternoons and the arrangement seemed to work well. Do continue to pray for all of these children in our parish, and their families.

Now, two requests. The first is quite straightforward. On Sunday 15th June Bishop Philip will be with us at Corpus Christi to celebrate Mass with the Sacrament of Confirmation. Afterwards, we'll offer refreshments in the Parish Centre. It would be great of a small team [perhaps 8-10 people] would take on making sure things are ready for people coming into the Centre after Mass. Food and drinks will be provided but it just needs a number of people to oversee things and ensure it all runs smoothly. It would require this team to be available in the Centre from around 12noon. If you could help and are willing to give a little bit of time in this way it would be much appreciated. Please let me know (or the Parish Office) if this is something you could do as a one-off.

The second request relates to my plan to establish a **Buildings & Site Committee** in the parish. With Aidan's retirement as Facilities Manager, we need to ensure that our buildings and maintenance issues are properly covered and I propose setting up a small Committee to handle these matters, working with me. Most householders deal with practical issues to do with their homes and I don't envisage this requiring special knowledge or skills – just a willingness to get involved with some of the practical stuff a parish like Corpus Christi needs done. If you'd be interested, please contact me (preferably by email). I'd like this Committee to be established and meet at least once before the summer break so please, give it some thought.

I know that the world in which we live today there are many demands on our time. The temptation is to think that others will volunteer when it comes to church-related needs but if lots of people give a little time then everything will be done. Leaving it to a few is neither fair nor practical. So, thank you for giving these requests serious thought and I look forward to receiving names! Father John
