SHOWING GRATITUDE TO GOD

We are entering that time of year when the harvest is celebrated. Harvest Festivals take place in churches and schools, timed to coincide with the gathering of the produce and fruits of the land. In North America 'Thanksgiving' seems to be a bigger event than Christmas! Thanksgiving tends to go beyond crops and fruit; we give thanks for all the good things we receive.

This year, we have the opportunity to demonstrate our gratitude in two ways: one focused on people far distant who have much less than we do; the other is reaching out to local people and families who are struggling. The first of these we do through CAFOD, the second by supporting the Bournemouth Foodbank.

CAFOD stands for the Catholic Association for Overseas Development. Set up by the Catholic Church in England & Wales fifty years ago, it can reach places where other charities struggle to reach. Sometimes using a partner agency called CARITAS, the money we give through CAFOD has made a huge difference to the lives of millions of people. Projects are designed so that communities are able to develop for the future - the best way forward. Giving aid helps with immediate needs but funding projects gives people dignity and hope for a better future. Please listen to the words at the end of Mass this weekend which set the scene for next Friday's Harvest Fast Day on 3rd October.

Corpus Christi Parish has always been a big supporter of the local Foodbank. Each weekend tins and non-perishable goods are left in the baskets in the entrance to the church. These are used by the Foodbank to support families, especially those with young children. Without these basic necessities many would really find life impossible as they struggle to make ends meet. As you can imagine, requests for help from the Foodbank are increasing as more people face the rising costs of living. Linked to Harvest, and in connection with the Harvest Mass with Corpus Christi School on 8th October, we hope to have an extra push for donations on the weekend of 12/13th October.

This means that, through the CAFOD Harvest Fast Day, combined with practical support for the Foodbank, we can give thanks in a tangible way for all that we have received.

Youth Mass. We are working to establish a pattern of Mass celebrated at 5pm on the first Sunday of each month where we focus more on our young people. There is music and a chance for young people to gather afterwards. The next one is on Sunday 5th October [the two after that are on 2nd November and 7th December]. Make a note of the dates and come and join in – especially if you are young! – but of course everyone is welcome.
