Teaching and Education

At the end of the celebration of Baptism there is a blessing for the child's mother, father and all present. The wording refers to the parents as "the first teachers of their child in the ways of faith" and adds: "may they also be the best of teachers bearing witness to the faith in words and action." One reason the Catholic community has invested so heavily in building schools has been to provide support to parents as they strive to fulfil the commitment they make when choosing to have their child baptised. Schools and parishes cannot do the job of parents – no one else can – but for a child to be part of a Catholic School community is invaluable.


This weekend we celebrate Education Sunday and take the opportunity to place before Our Lord in prayer all our schools, colleges, universities and places of learning. We pray for pupils and students, for teaching staff, other staff, governors, and the many who support the workings of these places which are so essential in the nurturing of young lives. We should pray too that others will be drawn to becoming teachers so that we are able to continue to offer families schools which are vibrant and centred on the principles of Catholic Social Teaching.

Of course, we all know that 'education' is more than academic learning. One of the greatest strengths of Catholic Schools is that they provide a well-rounded curriculum and approach to enable every child to develop their full potential. Not all of us are particularly academic, not everyone excels at sport, not everyone is a natural when it comes to computers, but we believe that God has planted within each of us certain gifts and strengths. Dedicated staff ensure that each young person is able to grow into the person God wants them to be. We are incredibly fortunate in this part of the diocese to have great Catholic Primary Schools and a Catholic Secondary School where the focus is always on the good of the individual child.

Bishop Philip's Visit. This Sunday we welcome our Bishop who is celebrating the 10am Mass with us, and then meeting parishioners in the Parish Centre. Interestingly, when defining the role of a Bishop, the Church places emphasis on his task of being a teacher. There are many other parts to the work of a Diocesan Bishop but teaching through his preaching, Pastoral Letters and other means lies at the heart. As a Successor of the Apostles, a Bishop is sent to a particular portion of the People of God – in Bishop Philip's case the Diocese of Portsmouth – to serve, to lead, to encourage and to affirm us in the faith that we share.

And finally, on this Education Sunday, some words of deep wisdom from Pope Francis: "Education is always an act of hope."
