## FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT Year A 30th November 2025

## The Season of Advent

Around the world, Christians mark the Advent Season with meaningful traditions that prepare the heart for Christ's coming. Customs include the lighting of Advent Wreaths and the use of Advent Calendars to count down the days until Christmas. In different cultures, unique practices bring added richness to this time of year: Italian shepherds play joyful tunes on bagpipes; families in Germany open daily doors on Advent Calendars; the faithful in Ethiopia observe a special fast. No matter how it is celebrated, Advent invites all believers to pause, pray, and reflect as we await the coming of our Saviour with renewed hope and joyful anticipation.

The Advent Calendar. Originating in Germany, the Advent Calendar has become a beloved tradition around the world. Each day of Advent, a small door is opened to reveal a surprise, often a treat or picture – but in its earliest form, these calendars contained Scripture verses to help families reflect on God's Word as they prepared their hearts for the coming of Christ.

The Advent Wreath. Made of evergreen branches symbolising eternal life, it holds four candles, one for each Sunday of Advent, representing hope, peace, joy and love. Each week, a new candle is lit as we draw closer to the celebration of Christ's birth. Many families and parishes also include a fifth candle, the Christ Candle, which is lit on Christmas Day to celebrate the light of Christ coming into the world.

Christingle. Originating from the Moravian Church, the Christingle is a symbolic tradition that reminds us of Jesus who is the Light of the World. It consists of an orange representing the world, a red ribbon symbolizing the shedding of Christ's blood in redeeming love, and a candle placed at the centre to signify His light shining in darkness.

Reflection and Charity. During Advent, many Christians take time to reflect on their faith and the true meaning of Christmas. It is a season of spiritual renewal – an opportunity to prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ through prayer, repentance, and acts of love. Many parishes and charities also offer ways to put faith into action during this holy season, such as fundraising and supporting food banks. These all remind us of our mission to share Christ's light with those in need.

Advent is a Season rich with opportunities to grow in faith, in hope and in love. Let's make the most of these few weeks in whatever way we can as we move towards Christmas.
